Additional information

Seat reservations are free of charge on all East Coast Train services.

Quiet Coach is located in Coach B. All electrical equipment should be used in quiet mode.



Pets : domestic animals on board free of charge as long as the pet does not occupy a seat.



Cycles are carried free of charge with a maximum of 5 cycles spaces per train. Reservation is compulsory.



Luggage: can't exceed 3 items, this includes 2 larger items, such as rucksacks or suitcases.
