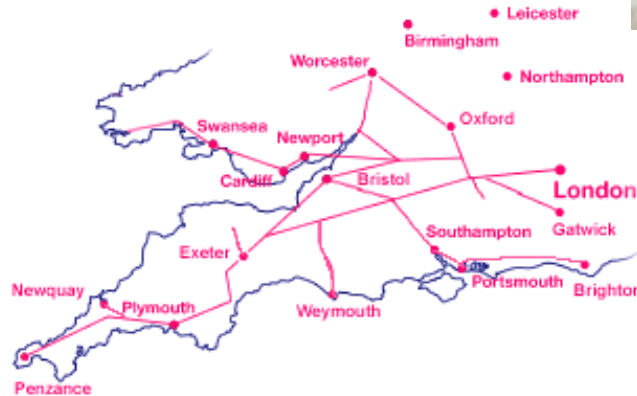


First Great Western

- **Standard Class**

Additional information:

Seat reservations: Customers who wish to make seat reservations on a First Great Western service at a time other than when they buy their tickets will be charged a £5 supplement per reservation.



Pets are welcome on board Grand Central services, free of charge, as long as they do not occupy a seat.



Cycles are carried free of charge. However, space can be limited, and there are restrictions on carrying cycles on busy high speed and commuter services. On peak services to/from London Paddington, cycle reservations are essential.



Luggage: travellers may take up to one piece of hand luggage and two other pieces free of charge on First Great Western services.
